### **What are cookies?**

A cookie is a small text file that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your device when you visit a website or use an app.

### **What type of cookies do we use?**

We use the following types of cookies:

#### **Necessary cookies**

These cookies are required for the administration and operation of our website. They are necessary for our site to maintain user sessions and prevent security threats.

#### **Analytical and performance cookies**

These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works. The analytics generated may be used to create reports about the use of our site and the analytics service provider will also store this information.

#### **Functionality cookies**

These are the cookies that help certain functionalities on our website. They enable us to personalise our content for you and enhance user experience by delivering content related to your preferences.

#### **Marketing cookies**

These cookies are used to personalise the content that we show so that they are meaningful to you and to keep track of the efficiency of our marketing campaigns. The information stored in these cookies may also be used by third party providers. Where we use third party providers, their details are included in the table below. <b>COOKIE</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
cookieLawInfo-checkbox-necessary/non-necessary	This cookie is set by the GDPR Cookie Consent plugin. It records the user consent for the cookies in the "Necessary" category.
viewed_cookie_policy	The GDPR Cookie Consent plugin sets the cookie to store whether the user has consented to use cookies. It does not store any personal data.
CookieLawInfoConsent	Records the default button state of the corresponding category and the status of CCPA. It works only in coordination with the primary cookie.
_cf_bm	This cookie is set by Cloudflare to support Cloudflare Bot Management.
JSESSIONID	Stores a session identifier so that New Relic can monitor session counts for an application.
mhVisitorId	<a href="#">We use cookies from a third-party provider called mhVisitorId Media Hawk to serve some website users a unique telephone number.</a>
ugid	Unsplash sets this cookie to enable the video content on the website.
yt-remote-device-id, ytidb::LAST_RESULT_ENTRY_KEY, yt-remote-connected-devices, yt-remote-session-app, yt-remote-cast-installed, yt-remote-session-name, yt-remote-cast-available, yt-remote-fast-check-period, yt-player-headers-readable	These cookies are set by YouTube to track and store user preferences for video playback on embedded YouTube videos.
YSC, VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE, VISITOR_PRIVACY_METADATA, PREF	YouTube uses these cookies to track video views, measure bandwidth, store consent states, and save user preferences for embedded videos.
yt.innertube::requests, yt.innertube::nextId	YouTube sets these cookies to register a unique ID to store data on what videos from YouTube the user has seen.
test_cookie	This cookie is set by doubleclick.net and it is used to determine if the user's browser supports cookies.
IDE	Google DoubleClick IDE cookies store information about how the user uses the website to present them with relevant ads according to the user profile.
MUID	Bing sets this cookie to recognise unique web browsers visiting Microsoft sites. This

	cookie is used for advertising, site analytics, and other operations.
_ga_*, _ga, _gid,	Google Analytics cookies are used to store and count page views, calculate visitor, session and campaign data, and track site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookies store information anonymously and assign randomly generated numbers to recognise unique visitors.
_gcl_au	This cookie is provided by Google Tag Manager to experiment advertisement efficiency of websites using their services.
vuid	Provided by Vimeo to collect tracking information by setting a unique ID to embed videos on the website.
player	Vimeo uses this cookie to save the user's preferences when playing embedded videos from Vimeo.
sync_active	This cookie is set by Vimeo and contains data on the visitor's video-content preferences, so that the website remembers parameters such as preferred volume or video quality.
_gat	Google Universal Analytics sets this cookie to restrain request rate and thus limit data collection on high-traffic sites.
_uetsid, _uetvid	Bing Ads sets this cookie to engage with a user that has previously visited the website.
_cfuvid	Cloudflare use this cookie to help websites manage traffic and speed up page load times
